### Create a Portal Team

Ideal team would include a member of:

- Administration i.e. Marketing
- IT
- Nursing
- Clinical Support staff i.e. front desk staff
- Billing if implementing bill pay

Meet weekly to keep the project moving



## Portal Implementation Quick Tips (cont)

#### **Portal Features**

- •Start small add features over time
- •Give consideration to developing internal workflow and processes; ALL information gathered will need to be processed by staff
- Give consideration to patient e-forms; cannot restrict how often a patient can submit information

   For example; BP readings, Blood Glucose etc could be sent numerous times in one day
- Give consideration to e-form versus secure message
   E-form creates a document in the chart secure message goes to a secure inbox.
